Falkland Palace

A picturesque town located in Fife, Falkland Palace is well known for once being the country residence of the Stewart kings and queens. Built between 1501 and 1541, the Palace has some of the most exceptional architecture of its time. It is also home to one of only two 16th century tennis courts in Britain.

St. Andrews

Known for its historic university, medieval streets and being the home of golf, St Andrews is a bustling town with plenty to see. We advise a visit to the castle, cathedral ruins and one of the three beaches. St-Andrews also offers plenty of varied lunch stops, we recommend The Sea Food Ristorante for idyllic sea scape views or for a more traditional lunch, visit Cromars Fish and Chip Shop and enjoy on the beach.

Crail

The quaint historic village of Crail offers charming cobbled streets that lead to the miniature harbour. Enjoy a coffee at the Crail Harbour Gallery and Tearoom as you look out to the Isle of May. Pittenweem

Pittenweem is a charming fishing village in the East Neuk of fife, with many of the picturesque houses around the harbour of traditional fife design. In the cliff face beneath the 12th century priory, St Fillian's cave once housed the eponymous saint and is now regarded a shrine for him. To gain access to the historic cave, Artisan Chocolatier and Cafe, The Cocoa Tree, provides keys to enter the cave and offers delicious hand made chocolate delicacies.
